SITUATION OVERVIEW

Grow Community is a new urban neighborhood on Bainbridge Island, just a 35-minute ferry ride from downtown Seattle. The community is one of five in the world – and second in the United States – to start construction on sustainable homes using the One Planet Living® principles as a framework for building healthy, vital communities. The Grow Community features a combination of 22 zero-carbon, single-family homes, townhomes and lofts in pocket neighborhoods. Each of Grow Community's 5-Star Built Green homes feature an energy-efficient design that incorporates building materials that meet or exceed the project's high standards for the ultimate in energy efficiency and sustainability. A key goal for Grow's developers was to eliminate vinyl-based materials from the project.

These products are made from patented Ultrex pultruded fiberglass, which outlasts and outperforms vinyl, roll-form aluminum and vinyl/wood composites with superior energy efficiency. The fact is, ENERGY STAR® qualified Wood-Ultrex windows can save 15% of a home's total energy bill.* In addition, Wood-Ultrex products are made from silica sand, a safe, renewable natural resource; and Ultrex requires 39% less energy to produce than vinyl. Ultrex fiberglass also stands up to seaside rain and wind to retain its beauty over time for Grow Community homeowners. Ultrex also performs long after other window and door materials have lost their luster. Integrity windows from Marvin® are built tougher, last longer, and protect better.
